The literary structure of 1 Samuel 4-7

(The ark stories + Samuel's emergence)

A. Israel is defeated under Eli's rule even though the ark was present, due to Israel's sin and unfaithfulness – 4:1-10

- B. Eli's house is judged/ the ark is captured 4:11-22
 - C. The ark in captivity the Lord defeats the Philistines 5-6:11
- B^1 . The ark returns/ Levites of Beth-Shemesh are judged 6:12-7:2

 A^1 . The Philistines are defeated under Samuel's rule after their repentance and restoration to God -7:3-17

^{*}In A Israel was defeated at Ebenezer. In A¹ the Philistines were defeated and this was memorialized by a stone named Ebenezer. These references to an Ebenezer form the bookends of this section.

[•] A and A¹ both have to do with a battle with the Philistines, but with opposite results.

[•] B and B¹ both have to do with judgment on the leaders of Israel - priests and Levites, and with the ark being captured and then returned.

[•] C is the center point and highlights that God is more than able to save Israel.
