Jesus walks on water

Mark 6:46-53

- **A. Jesus on land, a mountain, disciples on the sea:** ⁴⁶And after he had taken leave of them, he went up on the mountain to pray. ⁴⁷And when evening came, the boat was out on the sea, and he was alone on the <u>land</u>.
 - **B. The disciples struggle:** ⁴⁸And he saw that they were making headway painfully,
 - **C. Wind against them:** for the wind was against them.
 - **D. Jesus came to them:** And about the fourth watch of the night he came to them, walking on the sea.
 - **E. A ghost/disciples terrified:** He meant to pass by them, ⁴⁹but when they saw him walking on the sea they thought it was a ghost, and cried out, ⁵⁰for they all saw him and were terrified.
 - **E¹. It is I/don't be afraid:** But immediately he spoke to them and said, "Take heart; it is I. Do not be afraid."
 - **D¹.** Jesus with them in the boat ⁵¹And he got into the boat with them,
 - C¹. Wind ceases: and the wind ceased.
 - **B¹. The disciples struggle:** And they were utterly astounded, ⁵²for they did not understand about the loaves, but their hearts were hardened.
- **A¹. All crossed the sea, all on land:** ⁵³When they had crossed over, they came to land at Gennesaret and moored to the shore.
